## Synopsis

In light of the increase in public awareness towards nature and scale of urban development and impacts to the neighbourhood, "Community Engagement" has become a key DESIGN PROCESS in achieving consensus-building for major city developments in Hong Kong in recent years. Sustainable designs should embody the element of "CHANGE" - in terms of programme, nature, time factor and in response to climate. In this presentation, Lim will share recent examples to demonstrate how to undertake participatory design process related to community architecture and planning/urbanity at different scales, ranging from urban space, waterfront development, architecture for people and design for changes.
